Grand Puy Lacoste tops the value for money category for the third year in a row

List in order of preference your top ten value wines from 2012 (value wines are wines with an expected release price of less than £500 per case)

1. Grand Puy Lacoste

2. Clos du Marquis

3. Gazin

4. Domaine de Chevalier

5. Brane Cantenac

6. Clerc Milon

7. Croix de Beaucaillou

8. Alter Ego Palmer

9. Cantemerle

10. Haut Batailley

Those wines expected to be released at under £500 per case were ranked as above. Grand Puy Lacoste takes the top spot in the value wines top ten for the third year in a row, while Clos du Marquis and Gazin make impressive debuts as second and third place respectively.
